TGT Mathematics	<p>Essential</p> <p>1) Four years' Integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate ;</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subjects/ combination of subjects and in aggregate.
